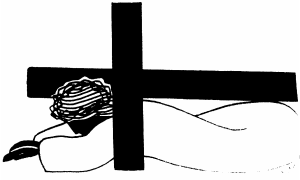

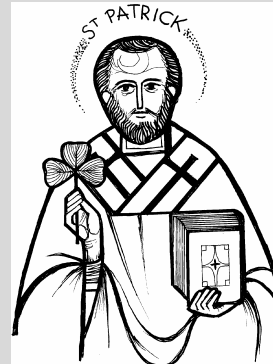

All things Irish for only £6 per adult & £3 per child. Support your parish by coming along for this fantastic evening.

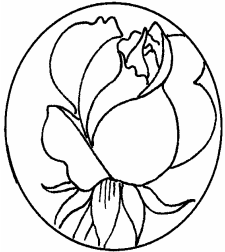
Bodmin Red box holders: your newsletters are at the back of church.
